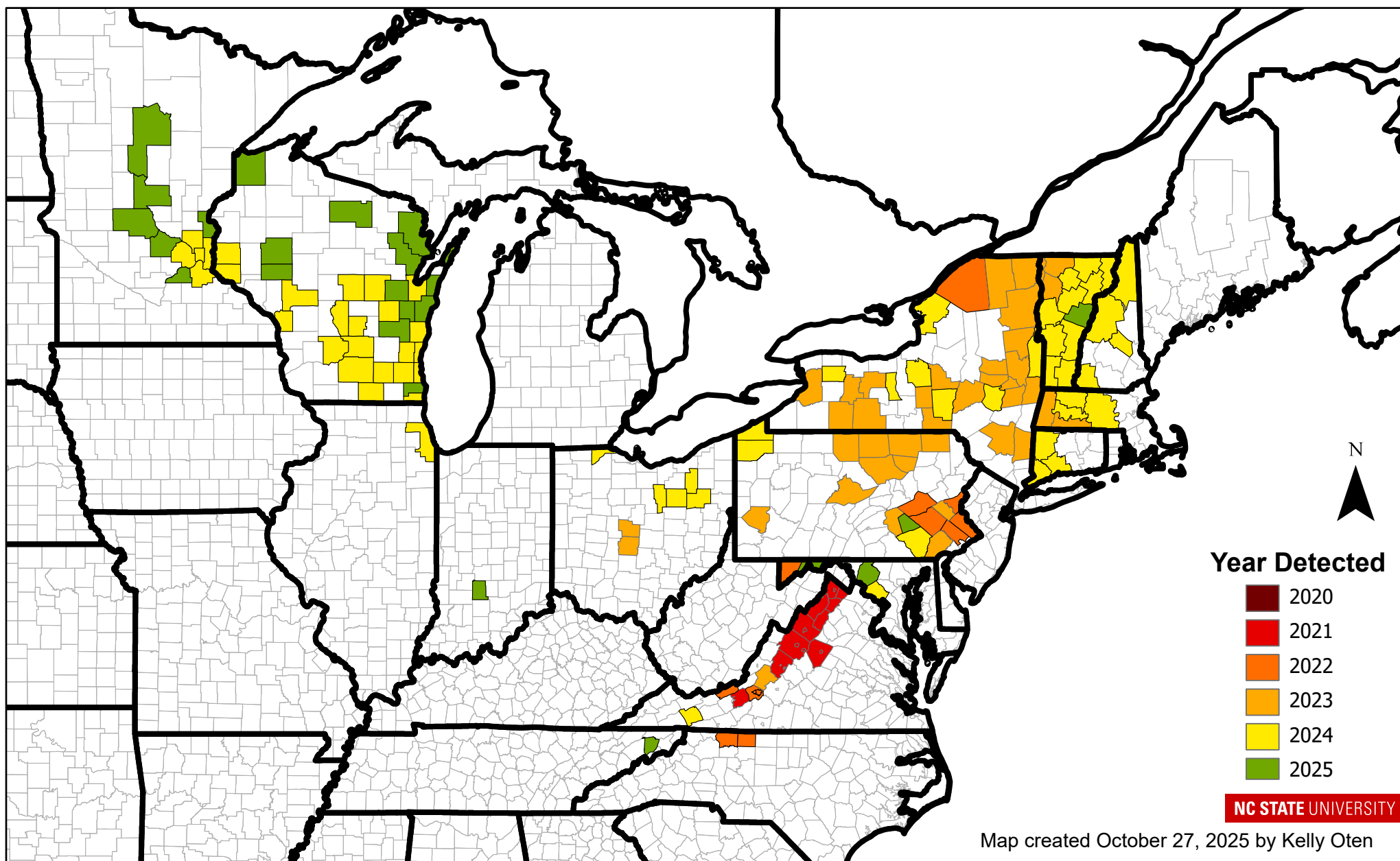


Elm zigzag sawfly (*Aproceros leucopoda*) detections in the United States
